## **PUPIL PREMIUM**

Is your annual income below £16190? Are you in receipt of income support, income based jobseeker's allowance, income related employment and support allowance, the guaranteed element of state pension credit or child tax credit, If so you may be entitled to receive free school meals. Even if your child is entitled to universal free school meals (YR to Y2) you can



still apply for free school meals, this in turn triggers a pupil premium entitlement which will stay in place for 6 years. At St Neot children in receipt of pupil premium receive extra teacher and teaching assistant interventions, free music lessons, subsidised school trips and residential visits, subsidised after school club attendance and additional resources. If you would like any advice or further information on how to apply please ask at the school office.
