St Neot School is holding a sponsored walk/run/jog around Sibbyback Lake on Sunday 21st April 2024 to raise money for school funds. The event will begin at 9.30am. Please assemble in the area by the activity centre at 9.15am. The distance around the lake is approx. 3.5m (5km). Please note that car parking costs £2.50 for 2 hours per car, we advise that you car share if possible. We will be walking/running anti-clockwise and there will be marshals around the lake. You are welcome to join in with your child during the event and all family members are more than welcome. No bikes or scooters please. Young children can be pushed in prams. Please wear suitable clothing and footwear. We will undertake a risk assessment, check weather conditions and confirm with South West Lakes on the Friday prior to the event to ensure it is safe to take place. Our PTA will be providing refreshments. Every school child participating will receive a medal.
