In Spanish, dates are given as cardinal numbers, e.g. 1, 2, 3 instead of ordinal numbers, e.g. 1st, 2nd, 3rd. **Mi cumpleaños es el veinte de marzo.** [My birthday is the twenty of March.]

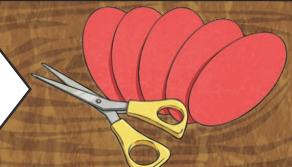
