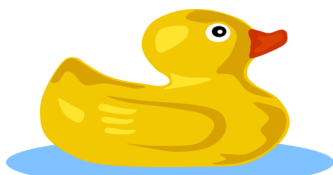
The Pinocchio film night was a successful event. All the children enjoyed the film and were very well behaved.
