#### ATTENDANCE UPDATE

The Education Welfare Service provides support for schools to meet their statutory requirements for pupil attendance, children missing education and juvenile employment. The Education Welfare Officers support schools to monitor and improve attendance in line with targets set by Government for all schools. This now includes a new referral threshold at <90% attendance: the threshold was previously <85%. At present we have 2 children below 90% and 3 just above. As a school we have a duty to report any children that have dropped below the threshold which will trigger involvement from the EWS. Approved absence includes illness and medical appointments. As you are aware the governors have decided not to authorise any holiday taken during term time. Term dates are available from the school office and on the website to enable you to plan your holidays.
