Please be aware of a new app aimed at children called Yellow. It is becoming increasingly popular with children but there are no age settings in place. A spokesman for the NSPCC said: "Any app that allows strangers to send photos to children or vice versa is troubling – particularly where the images being exchanged are of a sexual nature. And Yellow's settings that enable adults to view children, through a service blatantly aimed at flirting and relationships, also creates an opportunity for sexual predators to target young people. This needs to be urgently addressed".
