Can you please make sure that **all** items of clothing are named. It is very difficult to know what belongs to whom when the children get changed for PE if these things are not named.

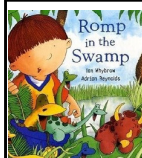
OUTDOOR CLASSROOM
