### KNOWLEDGE ORGANISERS

Our knowledge organisers for science, computing and languages are now on the school website under the curriculum tab. Others will be added over the next few weeks. A knowledge organiser sets out important, useful and powerful knowledge on a topic on a single page. Knowledge organisers are a summary of the key facts and essential knowledge that pupils need about a unit of work or a curriculum subject. They should be no more than one side of A4 with all the information broken down into easily digestible chunks. Research shows that our brains remember things more efficiently when we know the 'bigger picture' and can see the way that chunks of knowledge within that subject area link, forming powerful schemas. Making links, helps information move into our long-term memory.
