Thank you to the 38 families that returned the PE survey. It's clear that you made the most of the wonderful weather during lockdown and were very active!



Of the 38 surveys, 26 of you did PE with Joe Wicks. Many of you did it as a family and loved how he encouraged the children. Wearing costumes on Fridays and doing 'silly billies' were popular too.

We're incredibly proud of all the amazing activities you got up to. Lots of you went on long family walks, including hiking up tors. Many of you became more confident on your bicycles or learnt to ride without stabilisers. You also made the most of living near the sea and went paddle boarding, bodyboarding and swimming.

There were many proud moments such as growing your own fruit and vegetables, climbing trees, coming 'out of your comfort zones', doing charity challenges and learning new skills such as cooking, baking and gardening.

Out of 38 surveys, 20 recorded new foods tried such as chilli, scallops, home grown tomatoes, rocket, avocado, calamari, lentils, sweet potato curry, chicken noodles and dragon fruit. Wow-what a healthy and exciting range of food you tried! 30 surveys recorded baking and cooking; we were particularly impressed that some of you grew your own vegetables or went foraging for blackberries and used these ingredients in the dishes you made.

ST NEOT PTA 100 CLUB

The PTA 100 Club is now open for 2020-21. The 100 Club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, grandparents, carers, staff and friends of St. Neot Primary School. The club will run this year for ten months starting in October 2020.

For a cost of £1 per month (i.e. per draw), payable as £10 at the beginning of the school year, a member is allocated a number. The numbers are put into a draw where a winning number will be drawn at the end of each month, with a single prize of 50% of the monthly money received from the 100 Club, the other 50% will be used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for all pupils.
