Mental Health Visit

Strong Mental Health is our ability to cope with, and positively respond to, challenges.

We were delighted to welcome Kate Pordage, Cornwall Schools' Mental Health Liaison Officer, into school on Tuesday. Kate came in to discuss our Mental Health and Wellbeing approach and was very impressed with the strides we are making to ensure that our children have a good understanding of what Mental Health means. We do this through Jigsaw PSHE lessons, mindfulness sessions, Mental Health assemblies and of course, ensuring that our children enjoy 2 hours of PE weekly, at least 50 minutes of outside play daily and Wild Tribe Days to make the most of our wonderful natural surroundings.

Mrs Gouge, our Mental Health Lead, showed Kate around our lovely school and discussed the children's Well-being Journals with her. Kate brought with her a huge bag of free resources including mindfulness colouring, books for our Mental Health library, example journals and resources for our teachers to use within their PSHE lessons and mindfulness sessions. We are looking forward to welcoming Kate back next term and working with her to improve our Mental Health offer.

The KS2 children will receive a free Relaxation technique/Feeling safe card from Kate and Headstart Kernow today. We hope that the children will find these useful as a tool to calm them if they are feeling overwhelmed.
