This week the children have been having fun exploring the school and surrounding area with their new camera's. Take a look at what they have found.....



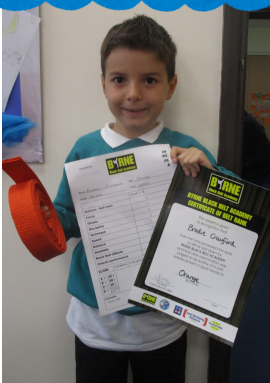
