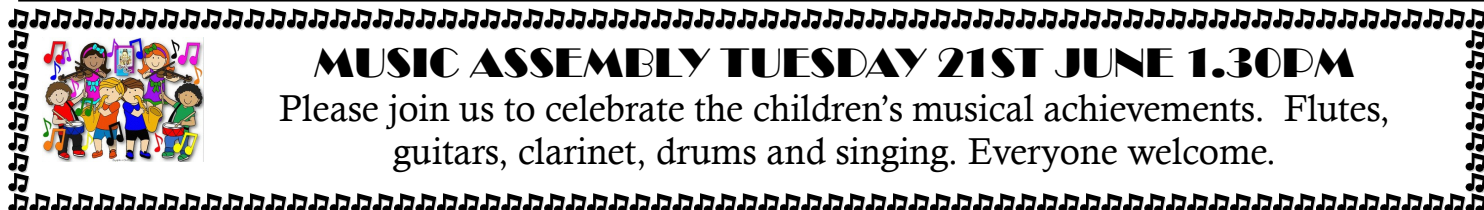

LETTER TO ALL SCHOOLS FROM NICK GIBB, MP, REGARDING TERM TIME ABSENCE

It remains the case that headteachers continue to have the power to authorise leave of absence, but only in exceptional circumstances. While family holidays are enriching experiences, the school year is designed to give families the opportunity for these breaks without having to disrupt their children's education. It is for schools to consider the specific details and relevant context behind each request. Schools know their pupils best and are well placed to make those judgements.

ST NEOT SCHOOL TERM TIME ABSENCE From September all absence requests will be taken to the governors and no absences will be authorised unless there are exceptional circumstances. These might include having to attend a funeral, unavoidable medical appointments, days of religious observance and external examinations, but not just because holidays are cheap or that family members can only take holiday during term time. All applications for term time absence will need to be brought into school at least 4 weeks before the date required with the exception of funerals.
